AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW PERTAINING TO SINGLE MEMBER HEARINGS BEFORE THE INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of Chapter 152 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by Chapter 742 of the Acts of 1972, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the word "compensation" in
4 line twenty-four, the following sentence:—in the event that
5 compensation has been agreed to and said agreement has been
6 signed and filed in accordance with this section, at no time shall
7 compensation be discontinued by the insurer unless a decision
8 has been rendered which is adverse to the injured employees
9 receiving compensation according to the remaining provisions of
10 this section.
