AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BRISTOL COUNTY MAY EXPEND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE RECREATIONAL, VACATION AND CONVENTION, AND COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL RESOURCES OF SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of Section 2 of Chapter 48 of  
2 the Acts of 1970 as amended by Chapter 163 of the Acts of 1971,  
3 by Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1972 and by Chapter 248 of the  
4 Acts of 1973 is hereby further amended by striking out in Line 5  
5 the words \$150,000.00 and inserting in place thereof the words  
6 \$200,000.00.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
