AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ELIMINATE THE FEE FOR PERSONS DESIRING TO TAKE THE GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT TESTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 the following new section: —

3 *Section 36.* The department of education shall not charge an
4 application or other testing fee for any person desiring to take
5 the general education development tests.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
