AN ACT REQUIRING PLANS FILED IN REGISTRIES TO BEAR THE SEAL AND SIGNATURE OF A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The last six words of Section 13A of Chapter 36 of the
2 General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out said six words
3 being 'shall be received for record therein.' and inserting in place
4 thereof the following: — "And no plan without bearing both the
5 seal and signature of a registered land surveyor as defined in
6 Section eighty-one of Chapter one hundred and twelve or a
7 registered land surveyor who is not a resident but has complied
8 with Section eight-one R, sub-sections (b) & (c) of Chapter one
9 hundred and twelve shall be received for record therein."
