AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REINSTATEMENT OF JOSEPH P. MURPHY TO HIS FORMER POSITION OF PATROLMAN IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the Director of Civil Service upon request of the
3 appointing authority of the City of Cambridge shall reinstate
4 Joseph P. Murphy to the position of patrolman in the Police
5 Department of said city, a position formerly held by Joseph P.
6 Murphy, provided the said appointing authority submits to the
7 Director of Civil Service in writing the reasons why such re-
8 instatement would be in the public interest.

1 SECTION 2. No seniority rights, probationary period,
2 preference rights, retirement rights, nor any other rights of
3 employment shall attach to the reinstatement to said position for
4 the former service in said position.
