AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE TOWN OF OTIS OF PART OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO ITS SCHOOLHOUSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay  
2 to the town of Otis such sums as would have been due said  
3 town from the commonwealth if an application for a state  
4 school construction grant for the construction by said town of  
5 an addition to its schoolhouse completed in the year nineteen  
6 hundred and seventy had been filed by said town and approved  
7 by the board of education under the provisions of chapter six  
8 hundred and forty-five of the Acts of nineteen hundred and  
9 forty-eight, as amended. Said board shall determine the  
10 amounts and the time of said payments, and shall certify the  
11 same to the comptroller as provided in said chapter six  
12 hundred and forty-five, and the treasurer shall make the pay-  
13 ments so certified to said town.
