AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROHIBITION OF JOB DISCRIMINATION BECAUSE OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 151B of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 216 of the acts of 1969, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out subsection 8 and inserting in
4 place thereof the following subsection:—

5 (8) The term “age” unless a different meaning clearly appears
6 from the context, includes any person over the age of forty.
