AN ACT ESTABLISHING A LOCAL SCHOOL COMMITTEE SCREENING COMMITTEE ON SEX EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 after section 38N the following section: —
3 *Section 38 O.* The school committee of cities, town and
4 regional school districts shall meet at least once every other
5 month with a screening committee to consist of eleven members,
6 one of whom shall be a physician and seven of whom shall be
7 parents of children attending a school of such city, town or
8 regional school district. The school committee in June of each
9 year shall appoint said committee. The committee shall meet
10 and advise said school committee concerning reading, visual aid
11 and all other material pertaining to sex education.
