**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING RETIREMENT TRAINING CLASSES AT STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION FOR PERSONS SIXTY YEARS OR OLDER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The board of higher education is hereby authorized and  
2 directed to establish retirement training classes for persons  
3 having reached the age of sixty years or older at no charge to  
4 such persons. Such classes shall deal with economic aspects of  
5 retirement, what to do with leisure time, and information  
6 relative to the services and agencies available to such persons.
