

By Mr. Bolling of Boston, petition of Royal L. Bolling, Jr., relative to regulating the training and examination of students and apprentices applying for registration as barbers. Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT REGULATING THE TRAINING AND EXAMINATION OF STUDENTS AND APPRENTICES APPLYING FOR REGISTRATION AS BARBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 87I of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the third, fourth and fifth sentences, as
3 appearing in section 2 of chapter 579 of the acts of 1948, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following:— Any such student
5 after having completed a course of at least nine months,
6 including at least fifteen hundred hours consisting of not more
7 than eight hours in any one day, of training in barbering in such
8 a barber school or barber college, may apply for an examina-
9 tion, or for a second or subsequent examination, if he has failed
10 to pass an earlier examination. Upon passing an examination
11 satisfactory to the Board, he shall be registered by the board as
12 an apprentice, and as such may practice barbering for
13 compensation under the supervision of a registered barber
14 during the period of such original registration, and thereafter,
15 upon payment annually of a renewal fee as provided in this
16 section. After having practiced for two years, nine months
17 thereof in a barber school or barber college, approved by the
18 Board, under the instruction of an instructor and fifteen months
19 thereof under a registered barber, and upon the payment of the
20 required fee for examination, such apprentice shall be eligible
21 for examination by the board of registration as a barber.

The Board of Directors of the
Company has the honor to acknowledge
the receipt of your letter of the 15th
inst. in relation to the proposed
amendment to the Charter of the
Company.

The Board has considered the same
and has decided to refer the same
to the Finance Committee for their
advice.

The Finance Committee will report
to the Board at its next meeting
on the 22nd inst.
