AN ACT ALLOWING LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITIES TO ISSUE SPECIAL
LICENSES TO SELL ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 14 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 253 of the acts of 1967, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence of the first
4 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following new
5 sentence: — In a city or town wherein the granting of licenses to
6 sell all alcoholic beverages is authorized under this chapter,
7 special licenses for the sale of such beverages may be issued by
8 local licensing authorities, to the responsible manager of any
9 indoor or outdoor activity or enterprise.
