AN ACT RELATING TO SEARCHES CONDUCTED INCIDENT TO AN ARREST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of Chapter 276 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the second paragraph, added by section
3 1 of Chapter 508 of the Acts of 1974.

The Employment of Members
