## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The annual amount of every pension, retirement allowance, or
- 2 annuity payable under any general or special law, to any former
- 3 employee of the commonwealth or of any county, city, town,
- 4 district, or housing or redevelopment authority, including
- 5 teachers, or to the widow or other beneficiary of such employee
- 6 shall be not less than three thousand dollars; provided, such
- 7 retired employee has attained age sixty-five and had twenty years
- 8 of creditable service.
