By Mr. Freeman of Chelmsford, petition of Bruce N. Freeman relative to reducing to sixty-five the age for eligibility of certain elderly persons for exemption from real estate taxes.

AN ACT REDUCING THE AGE OF SIXTY-FIVE FOR ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS FOR EXEMPTION FROM REAL ESTATE TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 456 of
3 the Acts of 1970, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines
4 4, 6, and 7, the word "seventy" and inserting in place thereof,
5 in each instance, the word: – sixty-five.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to taxes levied for the
2 year nineteen hundred and seventy-five and subsequent years.
