### AN ACT FORBIDDING THE USE OF ALUMINUM CONDUCTORS FOR BRANCH CIRCUIT WIRING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 3L of chapter 143 of the  
2 General Laws, as amended by section 18 of chapter 802 of the  
3 acts of 1972, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of  
4 the first sentence the following:- ;provided, however, such rules  
5 or regulations shall not authorize the use of aluminum  
6 conductors for branch circuit wiring.
