AN ACT TO PROTECT BUS BOYS AND BUS GIRLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The following sentence is added to the second paragraph in
2 Section 7 of Chapter 151 of the General Laws: — 'For the
3 purpose of this Chapter, bus boys and bus girls in the hotel,
4 motel and restaurant industry are classified as non-service or
5 non-gratuity persons and their minimum wages shall be those
6 minimum wages established by the commissioner or by the law
7 for other non-service employees who do not receive tips.'
