AN ACT TO PROTECT EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN LABOR SITUATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The following new subsection (5) is hereby
2 added to section 25(b) of Chapter 151A of the General Laws:—

3 (5) The individual is out of work during a labor dispute
4 involving any proceedings as to the employer's violation of any
5 federal or state statute, regulation or order pertaining to
6 employment or because of any proceedings as to any such
7 violation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon
2 passage.
