RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO REGISTRATION OF VOTERS BY MAIL.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-
3 tatives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to registration of voters by mail and the
6 appointment of a state coordinator to act in conjunction with
7 any federal law applicable to the subject.
