AN ACT ALLOWING MUNICIPAL LIGHT DEPARTMENTS TO PURCHASE SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT FOR UP TO FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS WITHOUT BIDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 56D of Chapter 164 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in chapter 643 of the acts of 1960, is hereby further
3 amended by striking the words "two thousand dollars" in the
4 second line and inserting in their place the words "five thousand
5 dollars".
