## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT CLARIFYING THE STATUTES REGULATING COMPETITIVE BIDDING IN THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR PUBLIC BUILDING PROJECTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph I of section 44G of chapter 149 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding the following after the word  
3 *certifies*: “that he customarily performs this sub-trade with  
4 persons on his own payroll and”.

5 Paragraph I to read as follows:— “The undersigned hereby  
6 certifies that he customarily performs this sub-trade with  
7 persons on his own payroll and that he is able to furnish labor  
8 that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor  
9 employed or to be employed on the work.”
