In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT ELIMINATING CERTAIN INFORMATION FROM THE RETURN FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATION AND TAXATION RELATIVE TO THE GAME COMMONLY CALLED BEANO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 39 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 3 of chapter 492 of the acts of 1974, is
- 3 hereby further amended by striking out the first paragraph and
- 4 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—
- 5 Any organization operating or conducting a game under
- 6 section thirty-eight shall file a return with the commissioner of
- 7 corporations and taxation, on a form prepared by him and
- 8 approved by the state tax commission, within ten days after such
- 9 game is held or within such further time as said commissioner of
- 10 corporations and taxation may allow, and shall pay therewith a
- 11 tax of five per cent of the gross receipts derived from such game.
- 12 All such returns and the amounts of all such payments shall be
- 13 public records.
