AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELIGIBILITY OF LEONARD MORENO FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of general or
2 special law to the contrary, Leonard Moreno, a permanent
3 employee of the department of education, state agency for
4 surplus property, shall be given full credit for all of his prior
5 service with the Commonwealth, including the state agency for
6 surplus property, and any and all service related in any way
7 thereto, by filing with the state retirement board an application
8 on the prescribed forms for membership in the state employees
9 retirement system; but he shall not be entitled to full credit for
10 such prior service unless, within six months from the effective
11 date of this act, he shall have paid into the annuity savings fund
12 of the state retirement system, in one sum, an amount equal to
13 the contribution he would have been required to pay had he
14 applied for membership and been accepted in said retirement
15 system when he would have been first eligible as defined by the
16 provisions of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
