## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT REMOVING LIMITATIONS OF INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES FOR DAMAGES OR EXPENSES ARISING OUT OF OPERATION OF VEHICLES OR EQUIPMENT OWNED BY MUNICIPALITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 100A of Chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 108 of the acts of 1965, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the words, "to an amount not  
4 exceeding fifteen thousand dollars on account of injury to or  
5 death of one person, or not exceeding seventy-five thousand  
6 dollars for any one accident, and not exceeding five thousand on  
7 account of damage to property" and inserting in place  
8 thereof: — to assume the full liability arising from such death,  
9 injury, accident or property damage.
