AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES FOR DISPLAY OF INDECENT ENTERTAINMENT ON LICENSED PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 10B the following section: —
- 3 *Section 10C.* The local licensing authorities may suspend or
- 4 revoke any license issued under this chapter to any licensee who
- 5 permits any obscene or indecent entertainment to be displayed
- 6 or presented in the licensed premises.
