AN ACT PROVIDING FREE MUNICIPAL AMBULANCE SERVICE TO PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out clause (21A), as appearing in the
3 Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following clause: —

5 Clause (21A), For the purchase or hire and for the
6 maintenance of ambulances; provided, however, that all cities
7 and towns shall provide free ambulance service to all persons
8 sixty-five years of age or older.
