## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS BOILER AND PRESSURE VESSEL CODES AND THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE CODE FOR POWER PIPING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.), as  
2 amended by Chapter 251 of the Acts of 1973 is hereby amended  
3 by adding two new paragraphs at the end of Section 2: —  
4 The American Society of Mechanical Engineers Boiler and  
5 Pressure Vessel Codes, Sections I, II, III, IV, V, VIII, IX, X and  
6 XI shall be adopted upon publication and become a section of  
7 the statutes contained in Chapter 146 of the General Laws (Ter.  
8 Ed.) without the necessity of any further action. The 1974  
9 edition of the code shall be the first edition to be adopted under  
10 this statute.

11 The American National Standards Institute Code for Power  
12 Piping, B31.1.0, shall be adopted upon publication and become  
13 a section of the statutes contained in Chapter 146 of the General  
14 Laws (Ter. Ed.), without the necessity of any further action. The  
15 1973 edition of the code shall be the first edition to be adopted  
16 under this statute.
