AN ACT PROTECTING EMPLOYEES WHO ARE SEPARATED FROM STATE SERVICE AS A RESULT OF REORGANIZATION, LACK OF WORK, ABOLITION OF POSITION, OR LACK OF MONEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 46 I of Chapter thirty-one is hereby further amended
- 2 by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:—
- 3 Any person whose name is placed on a re-employment list shall
- 4 receive preference in enrollment in any job training program
- 5 conducted by the Commonwealth under section 28A of Chapter
- 6 seven of the General Laws or otherwise, for a period of two
- 7 years from such date of separation.
