AN ACT EXTENDING COVERAGE UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY ACT TO ALL PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter nine hundred and forty of the acts of nineteen  
2 hundred and seventy-one is further amended to cover in the  
3 applicable sections all public employees but excluding all elected  
4 officials and temporary appointees by the executive and  
5 legislative branches of government.
