AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE LODGING HOUSE AND BOARDING HOUSE LIENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 140 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 513 of the Acts of 1972, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out, in the first sentence, the
4 words "inn, lodging house or boarding house" the third time
5 said words appear, and inserting in place thereof the the
6 words: — or inn.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 255 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 23.

1 SECTION 3. Section 31 of said chapter 255, as most recently
2 amended by section 12 of chapter 326 of the Acts of 1950, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the words "twenty-
4 three" and inserting in place thereof the words: —twenty-four.
