## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT EXTENDING FOR A LIMITED PERIOD THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE APPLICATION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW WHEN A POSITION BECOMES SUBJECT TO SAID LAW BY VIRTUE OF A CHANGE IN LAW OR RULE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 677 of the Acts of 1971 is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following
- 3 section: —
- 4 *Section 4.* This act shall cease to be operative on June thirty,
- 5 nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.
