AN ACT CONCERNING THE INITIAL APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COMMISSION AGAINST DISCRIMINATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Three commissioners of the Massachusetts Commission
- 2 Against Discrimination shall be forthwith appointed by the
- 3 governor in conformity with the provisions of chapter of
- 4 the Acts of 1975 amending general laws chapter 6, section 56
- 5 with the exception of the following provisions: —
- 6 (1) One commissioner shall be appointed for an initial term of
- 7 one and one-half years.
- 8 (2) One commissioner shall be appointed for an initial term to
- 9 two and one-half years.
- 10 (3) One commissioner shall be appointed for an initial term of
- 11 three and one-half years.
