AN ACT ABOLISHING FUNDING FOR THE SO-CALLED METCO PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All monies appropriated for the purpose of
2 implementing sections twelve A and twelve B of chapter seventy-
3 six of the General Laws which are unexpended as of the effective
4 date of this act shall revert back to the general fund and no
5 further appropriations for the current or next succeeding fiscal
6 year shall be made for the purpose of implementing said
7 sections.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
