AN ACT ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR EQUAL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES IN THE COMMONWEALTH'S PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1G of Chapter 15 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 3 of Chapter 802 of the Acts of
3 1972, is hereby further amended by inserting following the
4 nineteenth paragraph thereof the following new paragraph:—
5 The board shall issue regulations designed to achieve equal
6 opportunity for women and members of minorities in employ-
7 ment in public schools which regulations shall provide for
8 annual compliance reports.
