AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RETENTION OF RIGHTS OF EMPLOYEES CLASSIFIED IN GROUP 2 UNDER THE STATE RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision 1 of section 10 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 826 of the Acts of 1967, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 23 to 27, the
4 following sentence: — “If any such member, classified in either
5 Group 1 to Group 2, has not attained age 55 on the date of his
6 termination of service the normal yearly amount of such
7 allowance shall be equal to that prescribed for a member
8 classified in Group 1; otherwise it shall be equal to that
9 prescribed for a member in the group in which he is classified.”
