

By Mr. Frank of Boston, petition of Garrett H. Byrne and Barney Frank relative to increasing the salaries of assistant district attorneys for the Suffolk District and providing that such assistants shall devote their entire time during ordinary business hours to their duties. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE SUFFOLK DISTRICT AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH ASSISTANTS SHALL DEVOTE THEIR ENTIRE TIME DURING ORDINARY BUSINESS HOURS TO THEIR DUTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 16 of chapter 12 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by chapter 809 of the acts of 1974 is hereby further
3 amended by striking out all words, up to and including the semi-
4 colon in line ten, as appearing in section 1 of the said chapter
5 809, and inserting in place thereof the following two
6 sentences:—Assistant district attorneys shall receive from the
7 commonwealth salaries as follows:—for the Suffolk District,
8 one assistant, thirty thousand dollars; three assistants, twenty-
9 eight thousand dollars; six assistants, twenty-five thousand
10 dollars; ten assistants, twenty thousand dollars; eight assistants,
11 fifteen thousand dollars; and five assistants, thirteen thousand
12 dollars. Such assistants shall devote their entire time during
13 ordinary business hours to their duties as assistant district
14 attorneys.
