AN ACT REQUIRING FURTHER USE OF THE EXISTING PROBATE COURT BUILDING UPON COMPLETION OF THE NEW COURTHOUSE COMPLEX IN HAMPDEN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Upon the completion of the construction of the buildings and
2 facilities authorized by section one of chapter one thousand one
3 hundred twelve of the acts of nineteen hundred seventy-one, the
4 county commissioners of Hampden county are hereby authoriz-
5 ed and directed to renovate the existing probate courthouse
6 building and to reequip and refurnish the same for other county
7 purposes or, with the permission of said commissioners, for city
8 or state purposes.
