

HOUSE No. 3131

By Mr. Johnston of Marshfield, petition of Philip W. Johnston relative to clarifying the regulation of family foster care not supervised and approved by a licensed placement agency. Human Service and Elderly Affairs.

AN ACT CLARIFYING THE REGULATION OF FAMILY FOSTER CARE NOT SUPERVISED AND APPROVED BY A LICENSED PLACEMENT AGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of section 10 of chapter 28A of
2 the General Laws, as amended by section 2 of chapter 682 of the
3 acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 5
4 and 6, the words "family foster care which is not supervised and
5 approved by a placement agency."

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (b) of said section 10 of said chapter
2 28A, as so amended, is hereby further amended by striking out,
3 in lines 3 and 4, the words "family foster care which is not
4 supervised and approved by a placement agency."

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (c) of said section 10 of said chapter
2 28A, as so amended, is hereby further amended by striking out,
3 in lines 8 and 9, the words "family foster care which is not
4 supervised and approved by a placement agency."

1 SECTION 4. Section 11 of said chapter 28A, as amended by
2 section 3 of said chapter 682, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out paragraph (b).
