AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE TERM "GROUP CARE FACILITY".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 28A as appearing in section 1 of chapter
2 785 of the acts of 1972 is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 last sentence of the term "Group care facility" the following
4 sentence:—A group care facility for twelve or fewer children
5 has a public educational purpose for the purposes of section two
6 of chapter forty A of the General Laws.
