AN ACT ENABLING CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS TO HUNT AND KILL
ANTLERLESS DEER WITHOUT A SPECIAL PERMIT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Any licensed hunter, sixty-five years of age or older, shall be
