AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF LEAD PELLETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 66 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 66A.* A person shall not use lead pellets in the
- 4 hunting of wild waterfowl or wild birds. This act shall take effect
- 5 on July 1, 1976.
