## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMONWEALTH TO COMPENSATE CERTAIN RACING STEWARDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary any track  
2 steward appointed and assigned by the State Racing Commis-  
3 sion to any race track within the Commonwealth shall be  
4 compensated by the commonwealth, provided that the compen-  
5 sation paid to said steward is reimbursed on an annual basis by  
6 the track at which said steward is employed.

7 Said stewards shall be entitled to all state employee benefits  
8 accrued from the time of their initial appointment and  
9 assignment by the commonwealth.
