AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF PUBLIC DOCUMENTS BY THE SUPERVISOR OF PUBLIC DOCUMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding to the last sentence thereof the
3 following: — He shall by regulation take necessary measures to
4 ensure compliance with Section 10 of this chapter as to all
5 public records, as defined by clause 26 of Section 7 of Chapter 4
6 of the General Laws, made or received by any officer or
7 employee of a county, district, city or town or by any employee
8 of any authority established by counties, districts, cities or towns
9 to serve a public purpose.

1 SECTION 2. Section 34 of Chapter 262 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking out clauses 13, 13A, 22, 25, 28,
3 30, 30A, 32, 35, 44, 44A, 66 and 67.
