AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE BETTER ECONOMY IN THE AREA OF SERVICES PERFORMED BY CITY AND TOWN GOVERNMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Cities and towns and counties, including their police
2 departments, may not purchase automobiles of the passenger
3 type, including beach wagons, that weigh more than three
4 thousand six hundred pounds including normal equipment,
5 appurtenances, twenty gallons of tanked gasoline and the driver
6 to be considered to weigh one hundred and eighty pounds.
