## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ISSUANCE OF SEMI-TRAILER PLATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking therefrom that sentence inserted by  
3 section 5 of chapter 736 of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
4 sixty-seven and inserting in place thereof the following  
5 sentence:—The registration of every motor vehicle and trailer  
6 registered under this chapter shall expire at midnight of the  
7 expiration date appearing on said certificate of registration,  
8 which date shall not be more than twenty-four months from the  
9 effective date appearing on said certificate, or in the case of a  
10 semi-trailer not more than sixty months from the effective date  
11 appearing on said certificate.

1 SECTION 2. Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking therefrom subdivision (3) as last  
3 amended by section 13 of chapter 679 of the acts of nineteen  
4 hundred and sixty-five and inserting in place thereof the  
5 following subdivision:—(3) For the registration of every semi-  
6 trailer, thirty dollars for each calendar year.
