AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DUTIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PAROLE BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The last paragraph of section 4 of chapter 27 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 41 of chapter 426 of
3 the acts of 1973, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
5 sentence: — Members shall devote their full time during business
6 hours to their respective duties.
