AN ACT RELATIVE TO SURVIVORS' BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN FULL-TIME STUDENTS UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 793 of the acts of 1972 is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 2A, as appearing in chapter 459 of the acts of 1974,
3 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

4 *Section 2A.* The provisions of the first paragraph of section
5 twelve B of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, inserted by
6 section two of this act, as such provisions relate to any child
7 over age eighteen and under twenty-one, or to any child who
8 had attained age eighteen prior to January first, nineteen
9 hundred and seventy-three and is under age twenty-one, and
10 who is a full-time student, shall apply to any such child of a
11 deceased member whose widow, husband or legally appointed
12 guardian, had elected to receive allowances under the provisions
13 of said section twelve B, as the result of the death of the member
14 which occurred prior to January first, nineteen hundred and
15 seventy-three; provided, that such child is not married; and
16 provided further, that the continuance of the allowance for such
17 child shall be governed by the provisions of said section twelve
