*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The provisions of any General or Special Law notwithstan-
- 2 ding the Superior Court for each county shall be required to
- 3 remain in session and conduct the business of said court on a
- 4 full-time twelve month basis each year.
