AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO HIRE WINTHROP HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO MAINTAIN THE CLEANLINESS OF WINTHROP BEACH IN THE TOWN OF WINTHROP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to hire ten Winthrop high school students to
- 3 maintain the cleanliness of Winthrop beach in the town of
- 4 Winthrop during the months of June, July and August of each
- 5 year. For said purpose said commission may expend such sums
- 6 as may be appropriated therefor.
