## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF PROBATION OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 99A of chapter 276 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by adding at the end of the fourth paragraph  
3 the following sentence: — The committee shall provide in its  
4 standards that no person shall be appointed a probation officer  
5 unless said person is the holder of an associate college degree or  
6 better.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of said section one shall apply  
2 to appointments as probation officers made on or after January  
3 first, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
