AN ACT TO PROVIDE A GUARANTEED ANNUAL INCOME FOR THE ELDERLY OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, there shall be provided a guaranteed annual
3 income for the elderly of the commonwealth with provisions for
4 cost-of-living increases.
